


<u>Parking:</u> Parking lot with meters and street parking available.

Free parking is available along the street for 2 hours, and paid parking is available in City of Monterey parking Lot #4 next to the library.


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MIDDLEBURY INSTITUTE OF INTERNATIONAL STUDIES AT MONTEREY **CAMPUS MAP**


